



## **Policy for Illegal Players**

TASL requires all players to be currently registered and paid for your team and have a valid, NCASA player pass before playing in a TASL match. If the Team Captain is not in possession of the player's pass, the player must have certification from the TASL office that the player is in good standing and is allowed to play in the game with a valid photo identification.

An illegal player is defined as a player that does not appear on your team's TASL roster and does not have a current, valid NCASA player card specific for your team.

Examples of an illegal player: a player that was rostered to your team last season, or last year; a player that may join your team next week; a player that has not yet received a pass from NCASA; a player that has a pass for another team.

The referee crews are instructed to check your team's rosters and player passes before the match begins, and enforce the No Pass, No Play Rule. So be aware that if for any reason a player does not have his or her pass, they are not allowed to participate without certification from the TASL office.

A team in violation of this policy is subject to the following sanctions if it is confirmed that an illegal player has participated in any of their TASL matches:

The team score for the match shall reflect the game as a 3 - 0 loss.

The team standings will reflect a 3 point deduction in points.

The team, via the Team Captain, will be assessed a \$100 Illegal Player Fine.

The illegal player and the Team Captain will automatically receive a 3 game suspension.

Please report any suspected violations of this policy to the TASL office, including as many details as possible.
